Stephanie Wan is an Assistant United States Attorney with the United States Attorney's Office - Western District of Missouri. She has been with the Department of Justice since December 2020. As an AUSA, she specializes in prosecuting sexual exploitation of children, human trafficking, and violent crimes. Prior to joining the Department of Justice, Stephanie was the Chief Assistant Prosecuting Attorney with the Greene County Prosecutor's Office. She spent 13 years with Greene County, specializing in the prosecution of physical and sexual violence against children, child homicide, domestic violence, and sexual violence against adults. She graduated from the University of Missouri - Columbia School of Law in 2006. She graduated from Vanderbilt University in 2003, where she double-majored in Women Studies and English-Comparative Literature.
